New Mexico Water Trust Board Awards District A Grant/Loan For Construction Of Water Project

El Valle has been awarded a Grant/Loan from the New Mexico Water Trust Board in the amount of \$1.1 million at a 90% Grant /10% Loan ratio for the Phase 3A Water Project.

This first phase of the District's water distribution system has been planned in cooperation with Llano Quemado Mutual Domestic Water Consumers' Association and will provide water to the west side of Llano Quemado in the Cuchilla and West Romero Road area.

As many as 80 residences could be served by this five mile stretch of water line, and it is estimated that half of these residences will connect, as it is not mandatory to do so. Property owners connecting to the District's water system will be allowed to continue using their well for outdoor use.

Not only will this project provide clean drinking water to those residents who wish to connect to the District line, but it will improve water availability for fire protection as well.

Construction could commence as early as this fall or early spring.

Special Election for Continuation of Gross Receipts Tax

The Board of Directors of El Valle de los Ranchos Water & Sanitation District requests your support in the Taos County Special Election on September 3, 2013 in which the District is seeking approval of the continuation of a quarter percent gross receipts tax imposed on businesses within the District boundaries.

This election will be conducted via absentee ballots which will be mailed out in the month of August. If you are a registered voter of the District and have not received a ballot by August 20, 2013, please call the Taos County Clerk so that a ballot can be mailed to you. Please deliver your ballot by mail or in person to the Taos County Clerk no later than September 3, 2013.

Revenues collected via gross receipts taxes allow for the District to design and build much needed sewer and water systems throughout the District. We could not do this without your support. Thank you!

Phase 2C-1 & 2C-4 Out To Bid

Phase 2C-1 and 2C-4 are stand-alone construction projects and will cover the following areas of sewer line extensions:

2C-1: runs along Valerio Road East of the Old Santa Fe Highway on to Espinoza Road.

2C-4: runs from the intersection of Espinoza Road and Valerio Road, going North on Espinoza Road toward East Camino Abajo de la Loma.

Phases 2B-2 & 2B-3 Sewer Project Recently Completed

Construction of Phases 2B-2 and 2B-3 will allow several resi-
dences and businesses in the
greenbelt and the densely popu-
lated St. Francis Plaza area to
connect to the District's sanitary
sewer line. These have been
funded through a grant/loan of
\$860,000 at a 50% grant/loan
ratio from the New Mexico En-
vironment Department.

Phase 2B-2 takes the existing
sewer line from Abeyta Road
(off of State Road 240) all the
way to NM Highway 68.

Phase 2B-3 then takes the sewer
line from NM Highway 68 to the
Saint Francis Plaza and up to the
south entrance of the Ranchos
Post Office.

If you own property within 400
feet of the newly constructed
sewer line, please contact our
office so that you may begin the
process of connecting your resi-
dence or commercial property to
the sanitary sewer line in the re-
quired time frame.
